

Instructions for Completing the Waste Inventory Form

I. WASTE DESCRIPTION

- a. Describe, in as much detail as possible, the wastes you want to drop off at the collection site. Include the chemical and trade name, and MSDS, if available.
- b. Indicate the physical state of the waste: Solid (S) or Liquid (L).

II. GENERATION RATE

- a. Estimate maximum generation rate per month.
- b. Estimate maximum generation rate per year.

III. AMOUNT IN STORAGE

- a. Estimate amount of hazardous waste currently accumulated by your business.

IV. DISPOSAL RATE

- a. Estimate amount of hazardous waste to be brought each time to collection site. You are limited to 100 gallons per trip and no containers bigger than five gallons.
- b. Indicate desired frequency of disposal (weekly, monthly, annually, etc.),

V. CURRENT DISPOSAL METHOD

- a. Indicate how hazardous waste is currently disposed of by your company.

⁽⁴⁾Waste oil contaminated with halogenated solvents or PCB's will be charged at higher rate.

⁽⁵⁾Container size no larger than 5 gallon.
