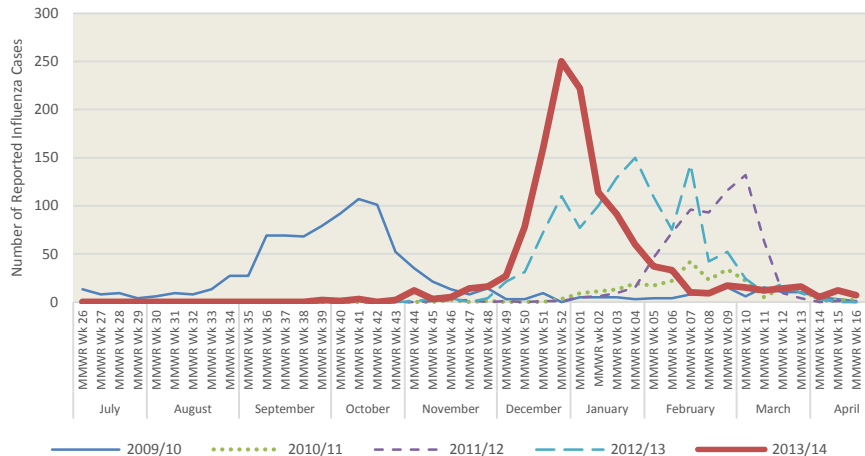

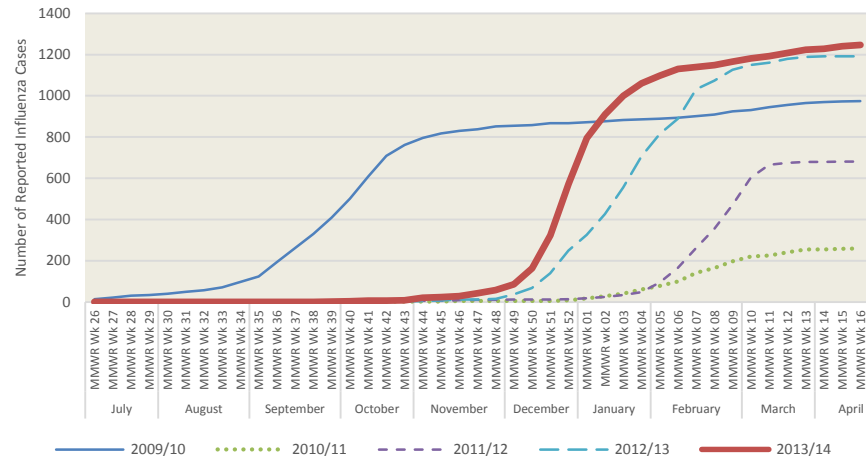
## 2013 - 2014 Influenza Surveillance Report

### Findings

- 1,247 influenza cases have been reported to date.
- 7 cases were reported between April 13-19, 2014.
- The reported number of influenza cases is 5 percent greater this year, compared to this time last year, and 28 percent greater this year compared to 2009/10 – the year of the H1N1 pandemic.
- The influenza rate is slightly greater among females compared to males.
- Incidence among individuals less than five years of age is nearly 3.5 times greater than that among individuals five or older.
- A majority of cases are type A.
