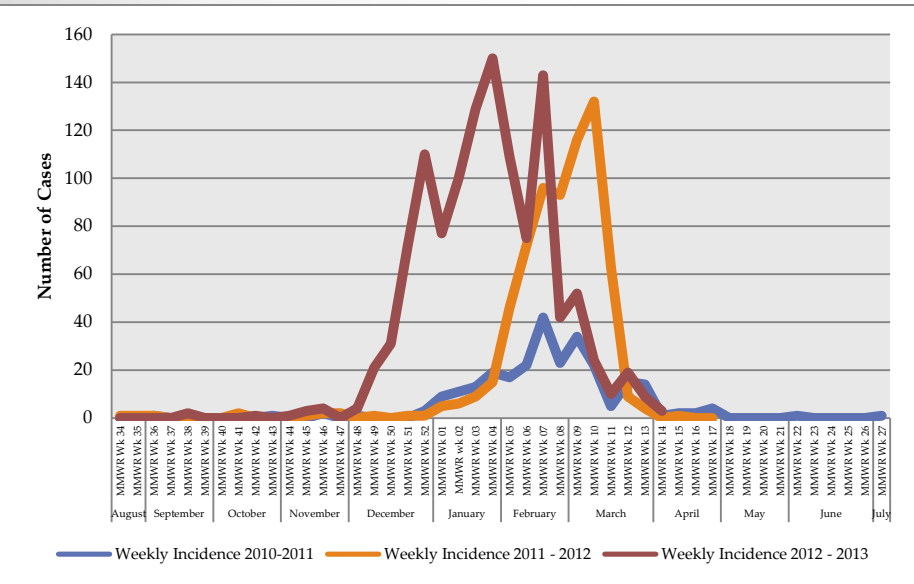


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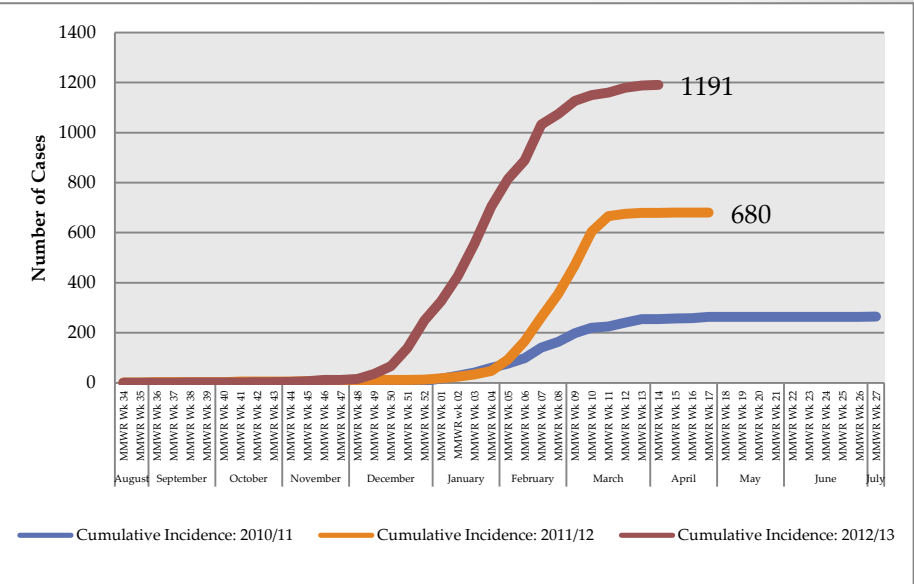
2012 - 2013 Influenza Surveillance Report

Findings

- Only three new cases were reported to JCDHE between March 31 and April 6, 2013.
- The total number of cases now exceeds the total reported last year by 511.
- Cases are evenly distributed among males and females
- The incidence rate is greatest among children less than five-years-old (616.2 per 100,000), individuals five to 24 years of age (333.3 per 100,000), and individuals age 65+ (249.9 per 100,000)
- The proportion of cases that are type A is greater than that observed early in the season.
