Johnson County health clinics temporarily closed for training

JOHNSON COUNTY, KAN. (May 23, 2019) – The Johnson County Department of Health and Environment’s (JCDHE) health clinics in Mission and Olathe will be temporarily closed after Memorial Day for staff training on a new electronic medical records system.

Walk-in services (immunizations, STD testing and treatment, pregnancy tests, physicals, tuberculosis tests) will not be available on the following dates:

Mission Clinic (6000 Lamar Ave.) — Closed May 27 through June 10, 2019

Olathe Clinic (11875 S. Sunset Drive) — Closed June 3 through 6, 2019

WIC (Women, Infants and Children) offices will remain open during this time to serve WIC clients.
