JCDHE asking health care providers to indicate interest in getting a COVID-19 vaccine for their staff

(JOHNSON COUNTY, KANSAS – December 17, 2020) The Johnson County Department of Health & Environment (JCDHE) is asking health care practices/organizations to indicate their interest in getting the COVID-19 vaccine for their staff. JCDHE asks that one representative from the practice/organization complete an online form so JCDHE can begin to assess the number of health care workers wanting a COVID-19 vaccine. By completing the form, health care practices/organizations will be placed on a list and will be notified if vaccine becomes available. Vaccine availability is not guaranteed.

JCDHE is following the vaccine distribution recommendations of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the Kansas Department of Health and Environment.
